

GETTING THERE & DRIVING TIMES

- Dunedin is just over 1 hour flying time from Christchurch, 1 hour 50 minutes from Wellington and a 1 hour 55 minute flight from Auckland.
- Dunedin to Curio Bay is a 2½ hour drive/179kms
- Curio Bay to Invercargill is a 1 hour drive/87kms
- Invercargill to Bluff is a ½ hour drive/26kms
- Bluff to Stewart Island is a 1 hour ferry ride
- Invercargill to Te Anau is a 2 hour drive/155kms
- Te Anau to Milford Sound is a 1½ hour drive/118kms
- Te Anau to Queenstown is a 2 hour drive/171kms

All driving times are approximate and do not allow time for stops. We recommend you allow extra time to enjoy your journey with safety
