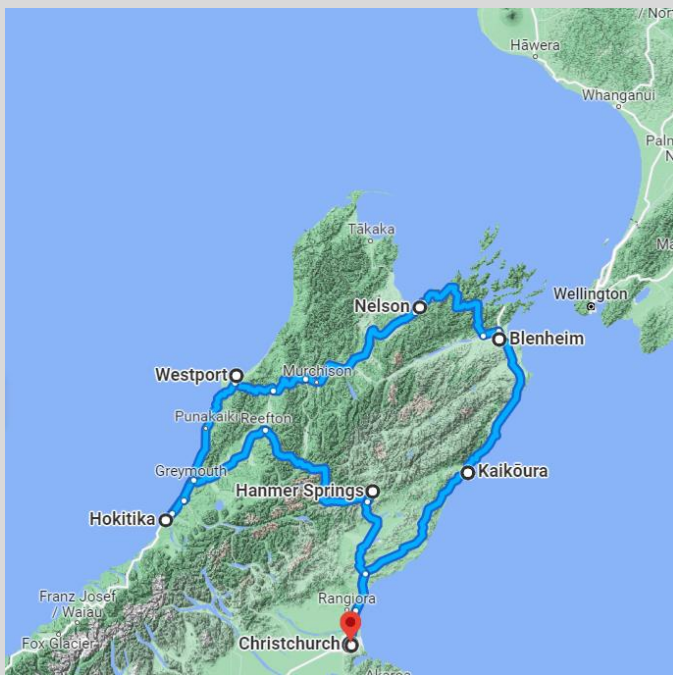


# TOP OF THE SOUTH EXPLORER



## Driving Times & Distances

- Christchurch to Kaikōura : 2½ hour drive/181kms
- Kaikōura to Blenheim : 1¾ hour drive/129kms
- Blenheim to Nelson : 1½ hour drive/115kms
- Nelson to Westport : 3 hour drive/221kms
- Westport to Hokitika : 1¾ hour drive/ 139 kms
- Hokitika to Hanmer Springs : 3¾ hour drive/253kms
- Hanmer to Christchurch:1¾ hour drive/ 133kms

All driving times are approximate and do not allow time for stops. We recommend you allow extra time to enjoy your journey with safety

## Itinerary Highlights

- After exploring the city of Christchurch on a Tram Tour, it's time to wave goodbye to the city life and head north to Kaikōura, a place of natural beauty, incredible wildlife and fun-filled experiences. Hop on a wildlife tour, paddle with dolphins, enjoy a whale watch encounter, learn about the local history and explore the bush tracks and coastline of beautiful Kaikōura
- Enjoy the coastal drive north of Kaikōura towards Marlborough and keep your eyes peeled for playful fur seals. Discover one of the best beer gardens in the country & let your imagination soar at the Omaka Aviation Heritage Centre.
- Half way between Blenheim and Nelson is the Pelorus Bridge where the Hobbit scene was filmed featuring 13 dwarves and Bilbo Baggins escaping captivity in barrels.
- Sink your teeth into adventure and some delicious, locally produced culinary products when visiting the Nelson region. Blow off some steam on one of the world's longest flying foxes at the Cable Bay Adventure Park and dip into the delightful world of Pic's Peanut Butter. For over 40yrs the Nelson Market has gained a worldwide reputation – from fresh fruit to high quality arts & crafts. Plan your trip so as not to miss this market.
- Adventure awaits around every bend as you drive along the Great Coast Road between Westport and Hokitika, one of the world's most scenic coastal roads. The Pancake Rocks at Punakaiki are the drawcard. Delve deeper into the area's rich history, meet some of the colourful locals, enjoy a visit to Shantytown and Gold Panning at Ross and immerse yourself in the beautiful untouched wilderness with a range of activities on offer.
- From Hokitika it's time to head inland to explore the incredible attractions at the resort town made famous for its natural hot springs - Hanmer Springs. This alpine playground has a huge range of activities, from bungee, quad bike tours, river rafting, jet boat rides, claybird shooting and more - Hanmer Springs does it all!
- After a leisurely start to the day visit the Hanmer Springs thermal pools for some relaxation before starting the journey south to Christchurch taking in the stunning vistas along the way.
