HIKING HOLIDAYS

Walking and hiking throughout New Zealand is the best way to see beautiful landscapes and explore vast wilderness areas. With thousands of kilometres of tracks, there are walking and hiking options to suit all levels of fitness and experience, from leisurely nature trails that bring unique ecosystems into focus, to challenging multi-day adventures in remote, untouched wilderness.

KEPLER TRACK

The full loop track is 60km long and offers a panorama of ever-changing scenery. Starting along the shores of Lake Te Anau, the track soon ascends the impressive Mt Luxmore before heading across tussock-covered ridgelines with vast views across Fiordland.
