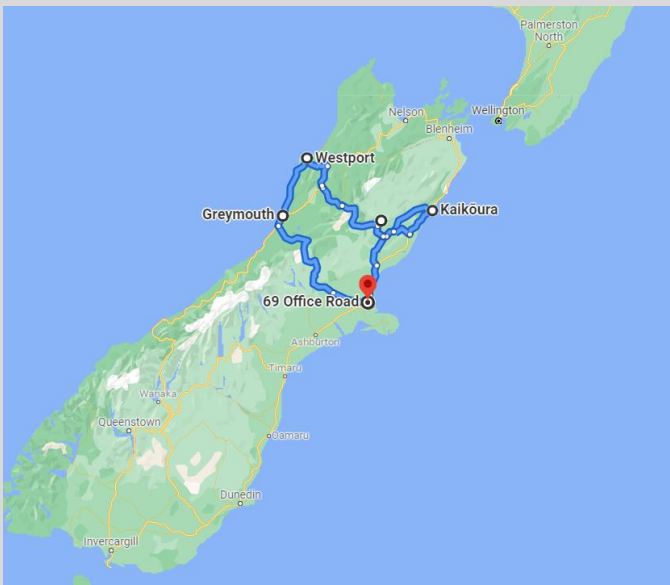


# OCEAN, ALPINE & THE SEA

## The New Route To The West Coast



### Highlights

- Choose your designated driver and target taking lunch at any one of the fine wineries on SH1 near Waipara.
- Kaikoura, best known for whale watching but equally well known for a good “feed” of crays! Pick up a snack at Nin’s Bin located on one of the most spectacular roads in the world.
- The Alpine Pacific Triangle route from Kaikoura brings you into Hanmer Springs via the Waioua River. Take a break at the Waiau River Estate situated high above the river.
- Before spas were trending, Maori in North Canterbury had discovered the “waters” at Hanmer. We’ve included entry to the springs to sooth any aching joints.
- Break the journey to Westport with a short nature walk and picnic at Lewis Pass. Or take a longer walk to the picturesque Cannibal Gorge, centuries ago a picnic site of a different sort.
- The historic goldmining sites and buildings of Reefton make for a must stop stop. The Reef Café is the pick of the eateries here.
- Just past the Inangahua Junction join the Buller Gorge and follow the Buller River through the earthquake riven landscapes on the road to Westport.
- Anchored offshore in 1769, Capt Cook named Cape Foulwind after the seal colony located south of Westport. Don’t let that stop you exploring one of the best coastal walks on the Coast.
- The Pancake Rocks at Punakaiki are the drawcard but get down on the beach at low tide.
- Greymouth, apart from being the Greenstone Capital of NZ is also home to Monteith’s Brewery. Great for lunch or just to take the tour...or call us to do both.
- Lake Brunner, near to Greymouth, was used as a backdrop and film location for the BBC series of Eleanor Catton’s Man Booker prize winning novel, “The Luminaries.”
- Near Arthurs Pass Village take time to walk to the Devils Punchbowl for a picnic before continuing to Christchurch. The whitebait sandwiches at Jackson’s Hotel are fantastic!

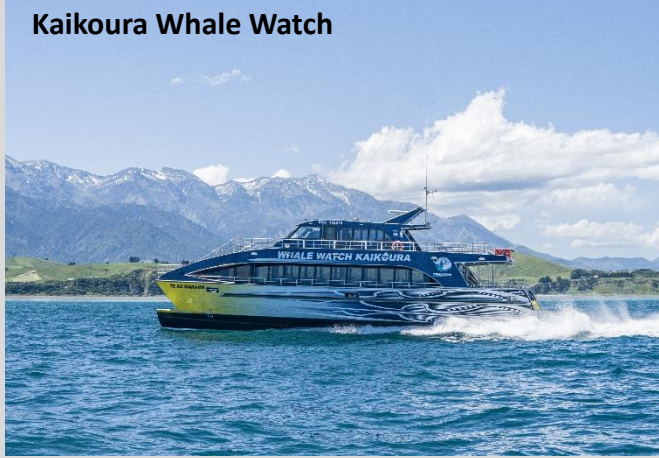
### Driving Times & Distances

- Christchurch to Kaikoura, 2½ hour drive/181kms
- Kaikoura to Hanmer Springs, 2 hour drive/131kms
- Hanmer Springs to Westport, 2¾ hour drive/216kms
- Westport to Greymouth, 1 hour drive/100kms
- Greymouth to Christchurch, 3¾ hour drive/243kms

All driving times are approximate and do not allow time for stops. We recommend you allow extra time to enjoy your journey with safety
