New Zealand's third largest island, located 30 kilometres South of the South Island. Here you'll get a glimpse into a simpler, slower lifestyle, in rhythm with the sea and the tides, attuned to the natural world of bush and beach.

Getting There

With regular flights from Auckland, Wellington & Christchurch into Invercargill getting to Stewart Island couldn't be easier. From Invercargill Airport the flight to Stewart Island takes approximately 15-20 minutes or take the 1 hour ferry trip from Bluff. Bluff is a 25 minute drive from Invercargill.

See & Do

With 245 kms of walking tracks, Stewart Island is a hikers paradise. Bird watchers are drawn here too especially with kiwi spotting trips. Take a guided cruise at dusk to Little Glory Bay to see kiwis feeding, explore Oban & the surrounding bays as a local guide gives you an entertaining insight into the community, enjoy a leisurely cruise of beautiful Paterson Inlet viewing hidden coves & unspoilt beaches before disembarking at Ulva Island, a renowned wildlife sanctuary, take a dip at Bathing Beach, a short walk from the settlement of Oban, check out the Rakiura Museum that's packed with info and artefacts regarding the history of Stewart Island, enjoy a fishing experience and get up close & personal with a great white shark, with a Shark Cage Encounter. These are just some of the activities on offer on Stewart Island.
