

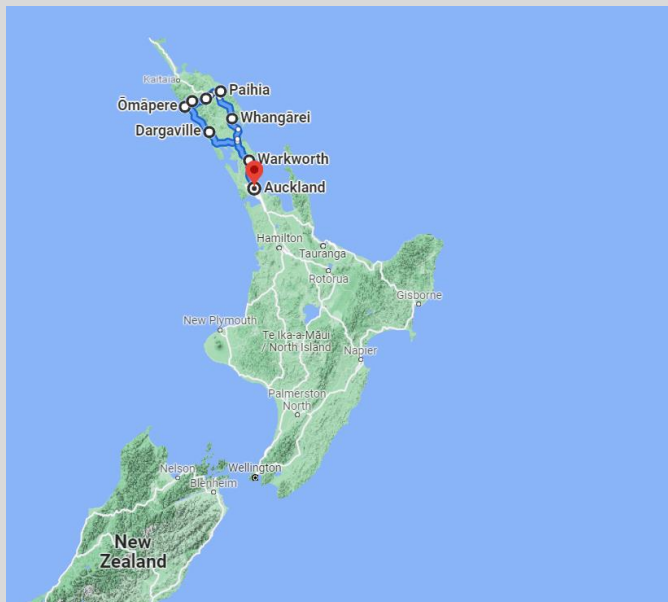

In The Footsteps of Kupe



Highlights

- The incredible Kauri Museum at Matakoho is like Dr Who's Tardis. The more you explore its exhibits the more you find and you just have to keep searching. It's more than a 10 minute stop so allow plenty of time.
- The multi media experience "In the footsteps of Kupe" is the only 4D experience of its kind in NZ with live action performers plus a surprise as you journey through the story of Kupe.
- Take the ferry across the Hokianga Harbour to Motuti Marae and the place where Bishop Pompallier the first Catholic Bishop of NZ is buried. Continue the story in Paihia at the beautifully restored Pompallier House.
- Head north from Rawene via the Wairere Boulders nature reserve to Mangungu Mission Station. This was the site of the largest signing of the Treaty of Waitangi and is also the burial place of Capt James Clendon, the first US Consulate in NZ. His restored house can be visited in Rawene.
- Continue on to Paihia via the beautiful Mission church at Waimate North.
- Paihia might be today's tourist hub but take the ferry to what, in its day, was NZ's first capital at the historic town of Russell. Formerly known as Kororareka, it also had the unsavoury title in whaling days as the 'Hell hole of the Pacific' visited by such infamous men such as Capt "Bully" Hayes, known as a South Seas Pirate and the last of the Buccaneers.

- Auckland to Hokianga, 3¾ hours/274 kms
- Hokianga to Paihia, 1¼ hours/75 kms
- Paihia to Auckland, 3¾ hours/228 kms

Cruise past the Cape Brett Lighthouse, before arriving at the majestic Hole in the Rock. Admire the rock walls towering above you as the skipper navigates right through the narrow space (conditions permitting) before heading back into the inner islands of the Bay.
