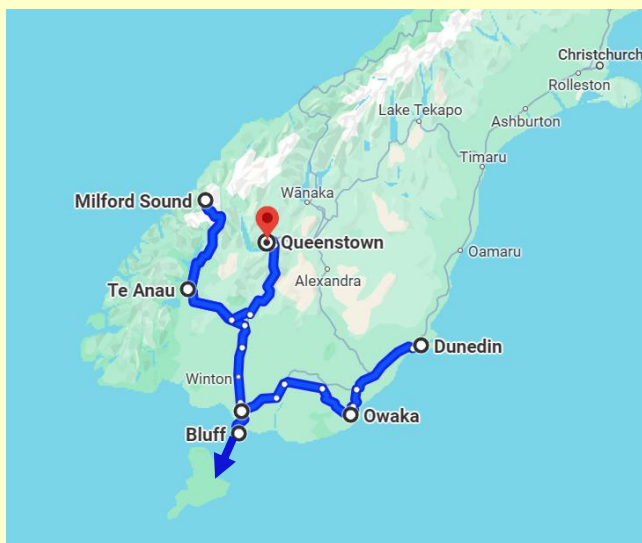
Highlights

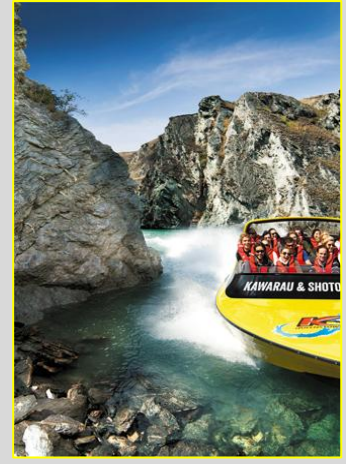
- The Wild Otago Peninsula, over endowed with natural beauty & precious wildlife including the endangered Royal Albatross, Yellow-eyed penguins and NZ Fur Seals.
- The Catlins, get here before the tourists find it. Almost too many highlights to list however get off Highway 92's tarseal & head down to Purakaunui Falls with your picnic.
- Other great places with great names between Kaka Point and Curio Bay are Porpoise Bay, Nugget Point, Jack's Blowhole, and Cannibal Bay. Although the only thing likely to eat you there are the sandflies, so bring repellent!
- The 180 million year old fossilised forest exposed on the outgoing tide at Curio Bay is one of the area's internationally significant marvels.
- Blue Cod Blues caravan near Waikawa, a basic food caravan but the cod "buttie", like the fruit ice cream, is to die for.
- Papatowai near Tahakopa Bay, is thought to be the last Moa habitat in New Zealand.
- In Invercargill, E Hayes & Sons, hardware is a rare find. Here, browse the power tools displayed beside vintage vehicles including the original Indian Scout of Burt Munro. Amazing!!
- Stewart Island is the last stop-off point before Antarctica & with over 1746 km² of largely untamed wilderness there's plenty of things to do. Whatever you choose to do, make sure to get some Fish & Chips at the Kai Kart where portions are big and served the Kiwi way. Nothing beats it !!
- Enjoy the cheeky kea, our mountain parrot, as you drive to Milford. Reputedly the world's cleverest parrot, don't feed them or they'll never leave !!
- The road to Glenorchy, probably the most scenic drive in NZ, should be a shared driving experience so you both can enjoy the views.

Driving Times & Distances

- Dunedin to Owaka, Catlins, 1½ hour drive/110kms
- Owaka to Invercargill, 1¾ hour drive/132 kms
- Invercargill to Bluff, ½ hour drive/26kms
- Bluff to Stewart Island, 1 hour ferry ride
- Invercargill to Te Anau, 2 hour drive/155kms
- Te Anau to Milford Sound, 1½ hour drive/118kms
- Te Anau to Queenstown, 2 hour drive/171kms

All driving times are approximate and do not allow time for stops. We recommend you allow extra time to enjoy your journey with safety
