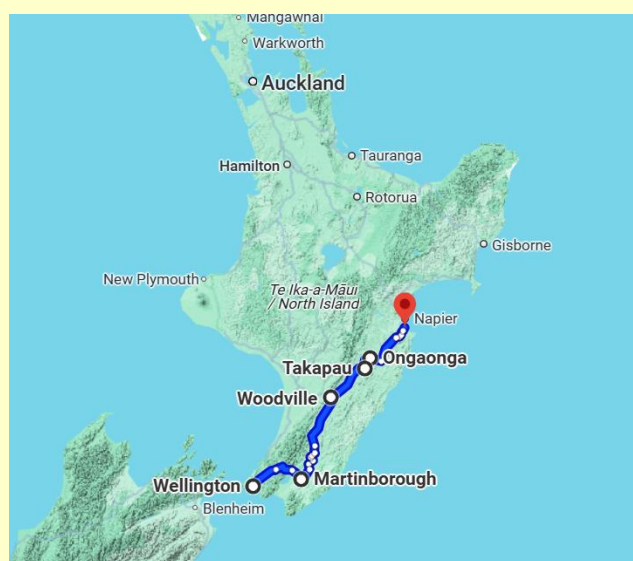

Driving Times & Distances

- Wellington to Martinborough, 1¼ hour drive/85kms
- Martinborough to Woodville, 1½ hour drive/125 kms
- Woodville to Takapau, 50 minute drive/65kms
- Takapau to Ongaonga, 15 minute drive/20kms
- Ongaonga to Napier, 50 minute drive/70kms

All driving times are approximate and do not allow time for stops. We recommend you allow extra time to enjoy your journey with safety

Highlights

- Wellington Botanical Gardens and the Cable Car ride
- The walk down from the Botanical Gardens through the cemetery exposes some of the history of Wellington and maybe world events including the grave of Harry McNeish who crewed with Shackleton on the journey from Elephant to South Georgia. 6 New Zealand PM's are also buried here.
- The Wellington Waterfront is a great walk before breakfast.
- Te Papa is always worth a visit even if you've been there already.
- The drive from Martinborough to the Castlepoint Lighthouse on the wild coast is stunning. Martinborough, is the original home of Pinot Noir production in New Zealand .
- If you regard cheesecake as an essential food group stop in to Yummy Mummy's in Woodville.
- If Akaroa is renowned for its Frenchness, then Dannevirke and Norsewood are as proud of the Scandinavian heritage. Visit the museum for a potted history.
- More food on this route. In Norsewood visit the world's smallest cheese factory at Rangiuuru and in true Scandi fashion, follow the kid's Troll Trail.
- While this route is renowned for wine, take time to visit the Tui Brewery not famous for much - Yeah Right!!
- Visit The Junction Vineyard in Takapau for plenty of kiwi hospitality and good wine. Sift through rugby memorabilia and have a chat to owner John Ashworth, a former AB.
- The small village of Ongaonga has possibly got the largest number of listed buildings of any small town in New Zealand.
- Up the road from Opuawharo is Taniwha Daffodils. Visit during September and join locals picking free daffodils. There are paddocks of them!
- Cape Kidnappers boasts the largest colony of Gannets in NZ. Best viewing is on a guided tour from Nov - Feb.
- If there's a world capital of Art Deco Buildings then it has to be Napier. Your tour will take you to visit some of these.

- ✓ 1 night Ashcote Homestead, Takapau in the Bayly Room with cooked breakfast
- ✓ 2 nights Scenic Hotel Te Pania, Napier in a Superior Room with daily cooked breakfast
