

Getting to Manapouri

Manapouri is about 3 hours from Queenstown and 30 minutes from Te Anau by road. We can arrange transfers at no additional cost from Te Anau or a coach transfer from Queenstown for an additional **\$100** per person or you have the option to self drive

Welcome aboard the Milford Wanderer

The Milford Wanderer, is a motorised vessel that has been purpose-built for navigating southern New Zealand. Designed along the lines of a traditional sailing scow, it has old world charm combined with modern facilities and the latest in safety equipment.

With a maximum of 32 passengers per departure, you'll enjoy a more intimate and personal cruise experience.

Please note this is a general guide only, all itineraries are subject to change based on weather conditions and crew judgement. All activities are optional and additional kayaking and walking opportunities are offered, where time allows. Itinerary is in reverse when the helicopter transfer is at the end of the trip.

Day 1 – Manapouri / Te Anau to Preservation Inlet
Cruise to the West Arm of Manapouri. Helicopter to Weka Island Barge to board your vessel and cruise to Preservation Inlet.

Day 2 – Explore Preservation Inlet In the morning visit the town site of Cromarty and the mining relics of Te Oneroa with a return walk to Puysegur Point Light House in afternoon.

Day 3 – Preservation Inlet to Chalky Inlet Visit the site of one of New Zealand's first operational whaling stations at Cu Cove. Take in the golden beaches of Spit Island. Cruise to Chalky Inlet, anchoring at North Port near the rusting hulk of the 1800s government steamship Stella.

Day 4 – Chalky Inlet to Dusky Sound One-hour walk on the beach at South Port visiting the old saw mill site. Embark on a three-hour (approx.) sea passage to Dusky Sound. Visit Pickersgill Harbour and Astronomers Point - named and used by Captain Cook during his five-week stay in 1773.

Day 5 – Explore Dusky Sound Start the day with a visit to early conservationist Richard Henry's house site on Pigeon Island. Cruise Facile Harbour, the site of New Zealand's first known European shipwreck. Cruise through Earshell Cove and the narrow channels of Resolution Island to The Basin for kayaking or a one - two hour walk.

Day 6 – Dusky Sound to Doubtful Sound In the morning visit Luncheon Cove, the site of New Zealand's first European and sealers settlement. Take a three-hour guided walk over predator free Anchor Island. Cruise through Acheron passage to Breaksea Sound and then approximately a three-hour sea passage returning to Doubtful Sound.

Day 7 – Doubtful Sound to Manapouri Cruise Doubtful Sound and lunch in Hall Arm. Leave the Milford Wanderer in Deep Cove and cross by coach over the stunning Wilmot Pass. Cruise across Lake Manapouri to complete your journey

Terms & Conditions

Price is per person share twin in New Zealand Dollars inclusive of 15% GST. Pricing is an **Indicative Price** and is correct at time of submission but is subject to change without notice. A **\$100** per person deposit is required at time of booking. Final payment will be required 30 days prior to the start of your Voyage of Discovery or as indicated on the invoice. If the booking is made within 30 days of departure then full payment is required at the time of booking. Payment is preferred by internet banking to the nominated account indicated on the invoice. Cancellations and amendments – Subject to your refund and remedy rights under the Consumer Guarantees Act, the following charges and cancellation fees apply to all bookings. All amendments to bookings will incur a fee of \$75 per person. Supplier cancellations, which can be up to 100% of the cost of the bookings, may also apply.
