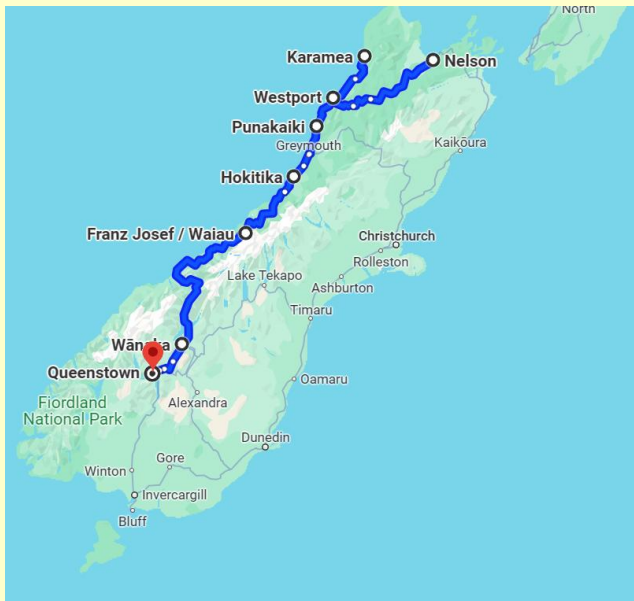

Driving Times & Distances

- Nelson to Westport, 3 hour drive/221kms
- Westport to Karamea, 1½ hour drive/90kms
- Karamea to Punakaiki, 2½ hour drive/144kms
- Punakaiki to Hokitika, 1 hour drive/84kms
- Hokitika to Franz Josef Glacier, 1¾ hour drive/135kms
- Franz Josef Glacier to Wanaka, 3½ hour drive/285kms
- Wanaka to Queenstown, 1 hour drive/69kms

All driving times are approximate and do not allow time for stops. We recommend you allow extra time to enjoy your journey with safety.

Highlights

- For over 40yrs the Nelson Market has gained a worldwide reputation – from fresh fruit to high quality arts & crafts. Plan your trip so as not to miss this market.
- The views from the Hope Saddle on SH6 over the Nelson Lakes and the Kahurangi Mountains are breath taking.
- Follow the Buller River through the earthquake riven landscapes on the road to Westport.
- Take a full day to drive to Karamea and discover the walks and historic mining settlements such as Denniston and Granity. Stop for coffee at a West Coast institution, The Cow Shed Café, just over the river bridge at Mohikiniui.
- One of the best short walks in NZ is to the 43m high Oparara Limestone Arch outside Karamea – bring a torch.
- Anchored offshore in 1769, Capt Cook named Cape Foulwind after the seal colony located south of Westport. Don't let that stop you exploring one of the best coastal walks on the Coast.
- The Pancake Rocks at Punakaiki are the drawcard but get down on the beach at low tide.
- Greymouth, apart from being the Greenstone Capital of NZ is also home to Monteith's Brewery. Great for lunch or just to take the tour...or call us to do both.
- The historic goldfields at Ross with the largest open cast gold mine in the Southern Hemisphere.
- The Glaciers of Franz Josef and Fox are major highlights on the West Coast. As too is the easy circuit around Lake Matheson, famous for its reflections.
- After leaving Haast and one hour from Wanaka, the Matukituki River & Valley come into view. Stop in this film location from the Hobbit to listen to the distant sound of ice tumbling off the glaciers.

The splendid isolation of Karamea is part of its appeal. All kinds of adventure activities can be organised here, including caving and kayaking. Limestone arch formations are a special feature of the area.
 - ✓ 1 night Scenic Hotel Punakaiki in a Beachview Studio Room with cooked breakfast.
 - ✓ Entry to Shanty Town Heritage Park. Set on 500 acres of native rainforest conveniently located just 10Km south of Greymouth and just 3kms off the main highway (SH6), you'll experience living history in a recreated gold-rush village. Learn about these pioneering stories through a fascinating mix of experience and displays with 30 shops and buildings to explore showcasing life in the early years of colonisation. Your entry includes access to all of the Heritage Parks exhibits, a steam train ride up, a gold panning tutorial & a souvenir of real gold.
 - ✓ 1 night Beachfront Hotel, Hokitika in an Ocean View Room with cooked breakfast.
 - ✓ 1 night Bella Vista Franz Josef Glacier in a 1 Bedroom Unit with continental breakfast.

A **\$100** per person deposit is required at time of booking. Final payment will be required 30 days prior to the start of your itinerary or as indicated on the invoice.
