

Driving Times & Distances

- Gisborne to Tokomaru 1½ hour drive/ 95kms
- Tokomaru to Hicks Bay, 1½ hour drive / 92 kms
- Hicks Bay to Te Kaha, 1¼ hour drive/ 82 kms
- Te Kaha to Rotorua, 2¾ hour drive/ 206 kms

Getting To Gisborne

- With up to five direct flights a day from Auckland to Gisborne it's an easy place to get to.
- There are also daily flights from Wellington to Gisborne.

All driving times are approximate and do not allow time for stops. We recommend you allow extra time to enjoy your journey with safety

Highlights

- Dive into the region's history, art, and culture with engaging exhibits at the Tairawhiti Museum.
- Take a wine tour of local vineyards, sampling renowned chardonnays and pinot gris.
- Relax on the stunning white sands or enjoy a surf at the popular Wainui Beach.
- Check out the Cooks Cove Walkway which offers breathtaking views of the coastline & an opportunity to explore the significance of the area where Captain James Cook once landed in 1769.
- Discover the iconic Tolaga Bay Wharf, the longest wharf in New Zealand and a popular spot to dangle a fishing line.
- Make sure to stop at Tokomaru Bay for a delicious Paua pie. This local delicacy is a must try.
- Learn about the area's whaling history at the Tokomaru Bay Whaling Station
- Try your hand at fishing, either from the shore or by chartering a boat.
- Discover the underwater world at nearby reefs around Te Kaha, perfect for snorkelling or diving.
- Marvel at the stunning coastal views and lookout for the iconic red flowering Pohutukawa trees.
- Enjoy a scenic walk around Lake Tarawera with stunning views.
- Experience a traditional Maori cultural performance and feast at Mitai Maori Village.
- For some pure relaxation stop off the Polynesian Spa in Rotorua, a popular spa retreat with mineral pools
- Take a walk through the Redwood Forest with its towering Redwoods

- ✓ A visit to the Eastwood National Arboretum (includes shuttle from Gisborne & entry) followed by an easy bike ride back to Gisborne- includes vineyard platter and wine tasting at one of the lovely Tairāwhiti Gisborne cellar doors.
- ✓ A 1 hour Reef ecology tour at Tatapouri Bay. Here you'll meet the children of the Maori sea God Tangaroa, walk across the Reef with experienced guides and interact with the Whai (stingrays, eagle rays), kingfish and other reef dwellers.
- ✓ **2 nights** Nga Puriri Cottage, Hicks Bay including cooked breakfast daily
Optional : Te Urunga-Tu Sunrise Experience- this early morning tour is a unique and unforgettable experience to greet the dawn in the land of the first light. Bundled up with helmets on, traverse the serene landscape by 4WD, cross fertile farmland and rural pastures until you reach the first point of mainland NZ to see the sunrise. **Add \$299** per person to the itinerary cost
- ✓ **1 night** Te Kaha Beach Hotel – Queen Room with sea views
- ✓ A 90 minute jetboat adventure down the Motu River
- ✓ **2 nights** Princess Gate, Rotorua – Estate Room including daily breakfast
- ✓ Mitai Maori Village - Māori and Island fusion extravaganza, including a feast.

Your journey ends at Rotorua Airport when your rental car is returned prior to your flight home.
